
POST-GRADUATION PLANS OF COMPLETERS (2014 - 15)

TOTAL COHORT RESULTS IN SECONDARY-LEVEL MATHEMATICS AFTER FOUR YEARS OF INSTRUCTION






UNWEIGHTED COMBINED ELA AND MATH PIS






OVERALL GRADUATION RATE FOR ACCOUNTABILITY





FOUR-YEAR GRADUATION-RATE TOTAL COHORT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY






FIVE-YEAR GRADUATION-RATE TOTAL COHORT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY








Graduation Rates for Regents with Advanced Designation and CTE Endorsement for Accountability
