The project will consist of the following:

**Port Dickinson Elementary**: Project includes bus loop pavement reconstruction, sidewalk replacement, paved play area reconstruction, chain link fence replacement, masonry/stone restoration, and window replacement.

<u>Middle/High School:</u> Project includes pavement reconstruction of drives and parking areas, sidewalk replacement, tennis court recoating, softball field netting, masonry restoration, gym floor refinishing, new backboard assemblies, new wall padding, new exterior lighting, and stadium lights.

<u>Chenango Bridge Elementary:</u> Project includes reconstruction of asphalt parking area, sidewalk replacement, masonry restoration, roof replacement, window replacement, and exterior panel replacement.

Pursuant to Education Commissioner's Regulation 155.5(d), the Chenango Valley Central School District will provide a safe school environment throughout this project, including an update of the school emergency plan to reflect any temporary exits or procedures needed as a result of the construction work at the school facilities. Fire drills will be held to familiarize students and staff with any temporary exits. The construction area will be separated from occupied areas of the building, all construction workers will be required to wear photo identification badges, and noise levels will be kept to a minimum while the building is occupied. All applicable federal and State rules and regulations will be strictly adhered to throughout the length of this project.
