RESOLVED, based upon the recommendation of Carmen A. Ciullo, Superintendent of Schools, that the Board of Education award the bid for **Refuse & Recycling** for the 2007-08 school year to the lowest bidder as attached,

5d) Statutory Installment Bond(s)

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Chenango Valley Central School District has determined that it is in the best interest of the Chenango Valley Central School District to provide for the issuance of Statutory Installment Bond(s); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined that said statutory installment bond(s) are necessary for the purpose of purchasing two 66-passenger buses, one 12-passenger wheelchair accessible bus and one 27-30 passenger mini-bus for use by the District; and

WHEREAS, Local Finance Law Section 62.10 provides for the issuance of statutory installment bond(s); it is hereby

RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Chenango Valley Central School District, in regular session convened, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be issued statutory installment bond(s) in compliance with Local Finance Law Section 62.10.

Section 2. The statutory installment bond(s) to be issued is for the specific object or purpose, or class of objects or purposes, described as follows: two 66-passenger buses, one 12-passenger wheelchair accessible bus and one 27-30 passenger mini-bus.

Section 3. The amount of the bond(s) to be issued for the object or purpose described in Section 2 is \$288,000.

Section 4. The period of maturity of the statutory installment bond(s) will be five years or less.

Section 5. The statutory installment bond(s) are not issued in anticipation of bonds for an assessable improvement.

Section 6. The Board of Education of the Chenango Valley Central School District covenants and agrees with the holders from time to time of the statutory installment bond(s) that the District will duly and faithfully observe and comply with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the ACode), unless, in the opinion of Bond Counsel to the District, such compliance is not required to maintain the exclusion of the interest on the statutory installment bond(s) from gross income for federal income tax purposes.

Section 7. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is five (5) years, pursuant to Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law. It is hereby further determined that the maximum maturity of the statutory installment bond(s) herein authorized will not exceed five (5) years.

Section 8. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell statutory installment bond(s), is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education of the District. Such statutory installment bond(s) shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said President consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 9. The validity of such bonds may be contested only if:

- 1. Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said District is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2. The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
- 3. Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 10. This resolution shall be published in full in the Press & Sun-Bulletin, the official newspaper, together with a notice of District Clerk in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 11. This resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be dated this 18th day of July, 2007.
