\$10,000 grant!

The Chenango Valley CSD is proud to announce a \$10,000 grant from the USDA-NIFA Food and Ag Service-Learning Program, aimed at enhancing our farm-to-school initiatives.

This grant, awarded in collaboration with Cornell Cooperative Extension of Broome County, Broome-Tioga BOCES, and the Food and Health Network, is part of a national effort to support local school districts.

The funds will support essential garden materials, providing students with hands-on learning about agriculture, nutrition, and sustainability. CV is one of eight participating districts in Broome and Tioga counties. The initiative includes specialized training from New York State Ag in the Classroom and partnerships with Binghamton University and the Rural Health Service Corps (AmeriCorps).

Messages from the Superintendent and Board President

Message from the Superintendent

I hope that your 2024 is off to a great start! As we approach the halfway point of the academic year, I want to express my gratitude for your continued support. Our chronic absenteeism rates have decreased by approximately 4% compared to this time last year, and our out-of-school suspensions have decreased by over 50%. Achieving this kind of progress requires a true partnership between home and school, and we are thankful for your collaboration with our Chenango Valley staff.

In my career, I have found that this time of year is often among the most challenging. It's colder, darker, and the weather can be unpredictable. I've encouraged our staff to continue building connections with students and to encourage them to attend school every day. We are grateful for your continued support in this endeavor as well.

We are also monitoring last-minute transportation changes, particularly at the elementary level. By "last minute," we mean any bussing change made on the afternoon of the same day for non-emergency reasons (such as having a playdate at a friend's house). While we understand these changes may occur from time to time, we recorded over 125 such changes at our elementary schools in December alone. These changes often pose challenges for our elementary schools in loading our buses safely and efficiently for afternoon dismissal. We kindly ask that any such changes be communicated as far in advance as possible.








CV Soccer All-State


CV Senior's Eagle Scout Project Provided New Gaga Ball Pit to P.E. Classes
