

Save the Date: Capital Project Public Vote on Tuesday, December 5th

On Tuesday, December 5, 2017 from noon - 9:00 p.m. in the Chenango Valley High School Auditorium, community members in the Chenango Valley Central School District will have the opportunity to vote on proposed improvements to the district's facilities in a public referendum. The proposed capital improvements project has been structured to address top priority capital improvements that include renovations, building system upgrades, and site work. The estimated total cost for this project will be \$15 million, with a local tax increase of \$0. This project was designed to maintain a consistent tax effort for CV taxpayers.

Below are some of the proposed upgrades that are being considered for this project:

- Elementary classroom renovations
- Creation of STEAM classrooms
- Classroom LED lighting replacements
- Elementary corridor finish improvements
- Window replacements
- Mechanical system replacements
- Nurses office expansion at Chenango Bridge

- Sustainable classroom adjacent to Middle School/High School pond
- Gymnasium renovations
- New stadium lights
- Middle School/High School fitness room expansion
- Library renovations
- High School cafeteria expansion
- Pavement and sidewalk reconstruction
- Roof replacements

Total projected cost:	\$15,000,000
Capital reserves:	\$2,000,000
State aid:	\$11,664,000
Scheduled reduction in	
local share of existing debt:	\$1,336,000
Net local share:	\$0

The project scope of work, when combined with existing project debt service, will result in no net tax levy impact (on average) for CV taxpayers.
