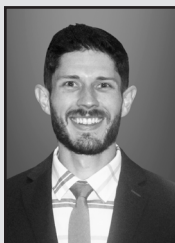

## Food Services Information for the 2023-24 School Year

With the ongoing goal to ensure that students have access to affordable and nutritious meals, we are excited to share that lunch prices will be reduced to \$1 for all Chenango Bridge Elementary, CV Middle School, and CV High School students for the 2023-24 school year. Our food service department has a surplus fund balance due partly to the COVID-19 pandemic, when all school lunches were free to all students and fully reimbursed to the district. The proposed lunch prices will not be sustainable long-term, so we will reassess them next summer to determine if they need to increase.

Port Dickinson Elementary School meets specific Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) criteria beginning on July 1, 2023. Therefore, we can offer Port Dickinson Elementary students free lunches for the 2023-24 school year.

We are also happy to share that all Chenango Valley students will continue to receive free school breakfasts for the 2023-24 school year.

## Capital Project Update

The Chenango Valley Middle/High School campus remains closed to the public for safety reasons during the summer months as construction is underway. Summer construction work at Port Dickinson and Chenango Bridge Elementary Schools is less extensive than the CV Middle/High School, but access will be restricted to certain areas. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.



Updates will be posted on the CV website.

### A reminder of some renovations to look forward to:

- A majority of the CV Middle/High School parking areas will be completely reconstructed.
- An additional small parking area will be created near the softball field.
- Athletic site improvements include new tennis courts and installation of field lights at the multipurpose field as well as additional bleachers.
- Inside the CV Middle/High School building, there will be some renovations to existing spaces as well as ongoing replacement of the HVAC equipment, which is part of the stimulus project.
- A retaining wall and a new marquee sign will be at the entrance of the CV Middle/High School campus.

*This summer's construction will complete the project's first phase, with the second phase occurring in the summer of 2024.*

## Public Notice

The Chenango Valley Central School District has completed the inspection of all schools and buildings to determine the condition of asbestos that is present, and whether any action is required to avoid potential health hazards for students, employees, and visitors. A management plan has been developed in accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), to ensure the continued provision and maintenance of a safe environment for students, employees, and visitors. The management plan includes training of maintenance staff to prevent disturbance of asbestos, periodic re-inspection, and surveillance.

Please note that the comprehensive, triennial inspection occurs once every three years. A surveillance inspection of the asbestos containing building materials occurs every six months, typically during the months of December and July. Monitoring of these building materials occurs on a continuing basis. A copy of the management plan is available at the district office. ## Important Message from Our Health Office Regarding Nut Allergies

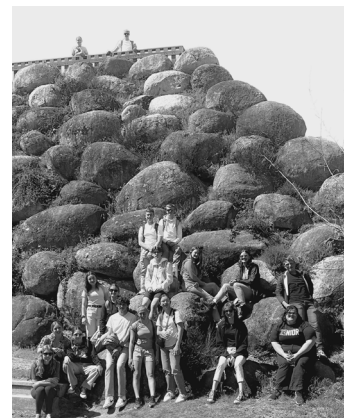
## CV French Exchange Program Embarks on Unforgettable Trip

In March, 18 Chenango Valley High School students and five chaperones left on a trip of a lifetime to France! The trip began with a weekend in Paris seeing iconic sights, including the Eiffel Tower; the Arc de Triomphe; Musée Fragonard, where they learned about the history of how perfume is made; Musée du Chocolat, where they saw, learned about, and tasted delicious chocolates; Le Musée Jacquemart André, where they saw the expansive collection of art amassed by the couple in their private home during their lifetime; and the Opéra Garnier, home of the famous phantom. For a special treat, dinner was at the oldest café in Paris, Le Procope, where the students tried many fine French foods!

The trip continued in the south of France in the small city of Castres, following a journey across the country. The CV students stayed with participating students from our exchange partner school, La Borde Basse. Besides attending and participating in classes at La Borde Basse, the teachers arranged field trips to nearby points of interest. These trips included the city of Albi, home of the artist Toulouse Lautrec and the location of the magnificent cathedral of Sainte Cécile; the city of Toulouse, the center of the French aerospace industry; and Carcassonne, a fairy tale fortress castle that continues to house a substantial population within its walls even today.

For most of the CV students, the highlights of the trip were living with a French family and being able to attend classes with French students. Both of these are unique experiences most travelers don't get to enjoy. The students from La Borde Basse visited Chenango Valley in October, so this was also a chance to renew friendships.

The student participants and exchange director, Madame Henyan, wish to thank Chenango Valley for the continued support of an exchange program that has existed for over thirty years and has been so meaningful to many students and families in the CV district. We treasure our longstanding friendship and hope to continue the bond between these two cities and schools for many more years.

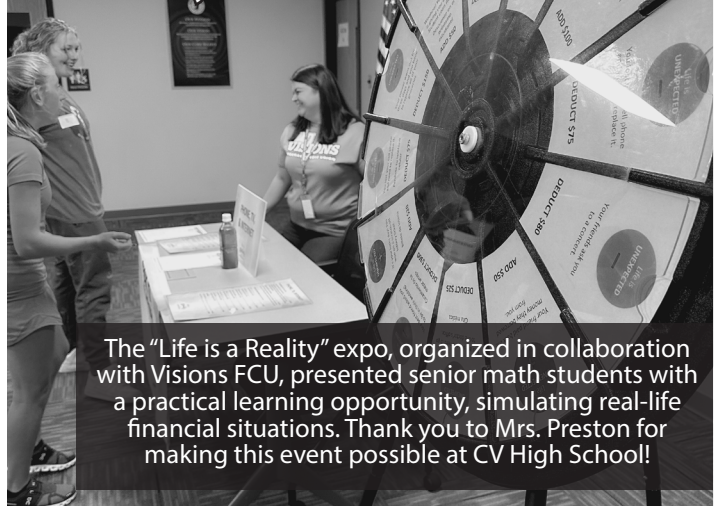

### PD Elementary Celebrates Flag Day

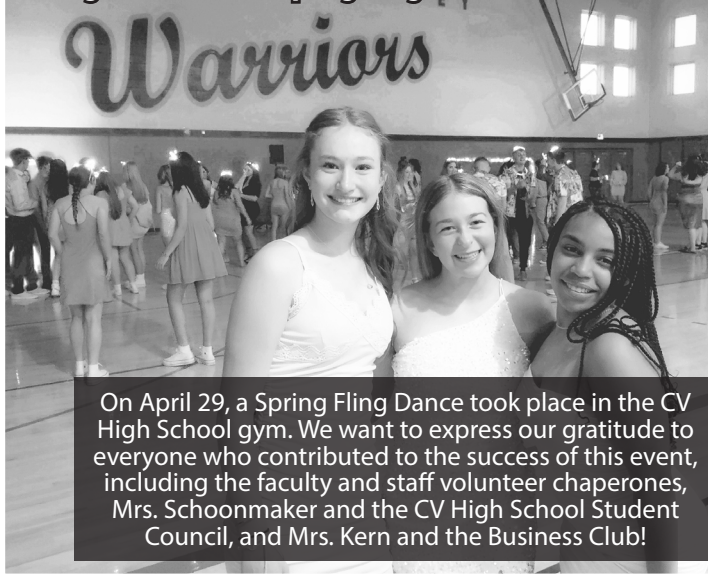

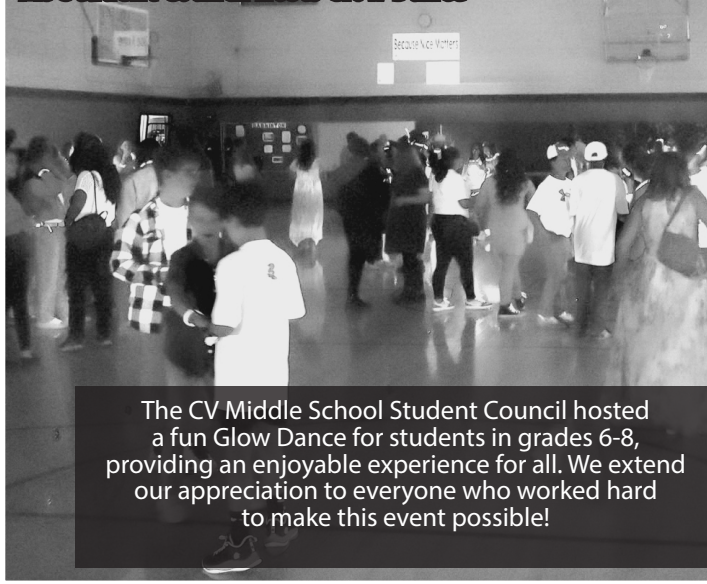

### MS Student Council Hosts Glow Dance



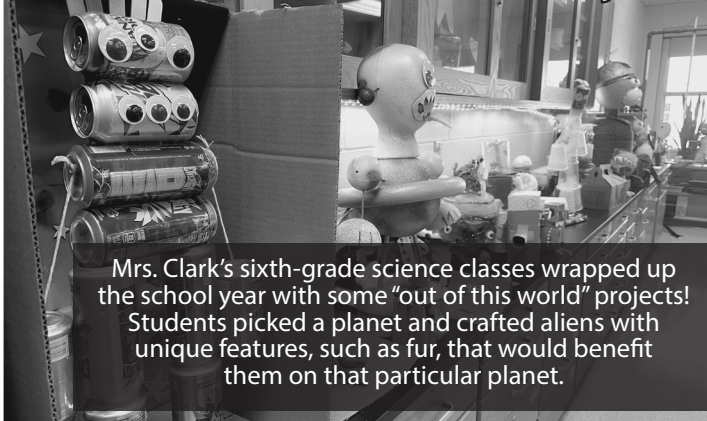

### MS Students Create 'Out of this World' Science Projects



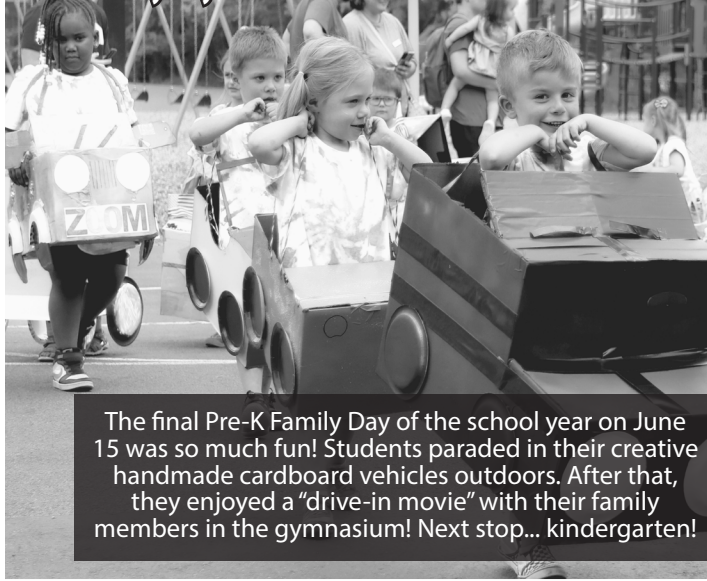

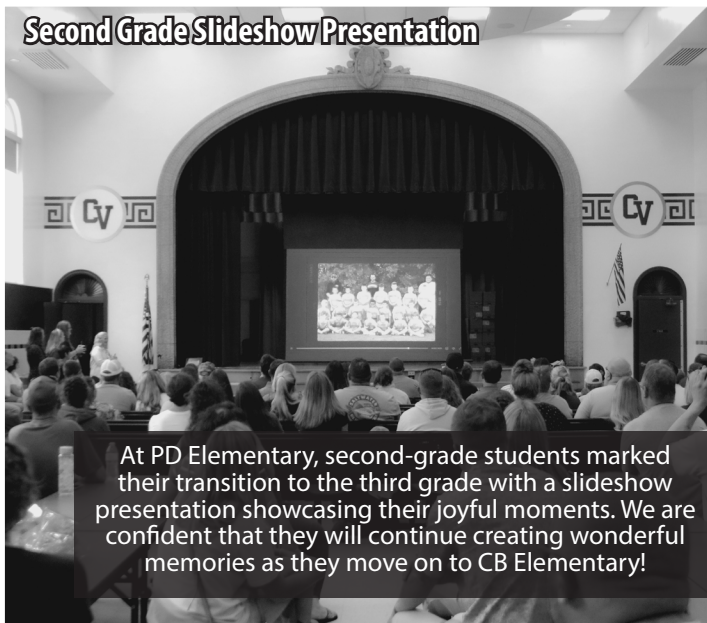

### Second Grade Slideshow Presentation



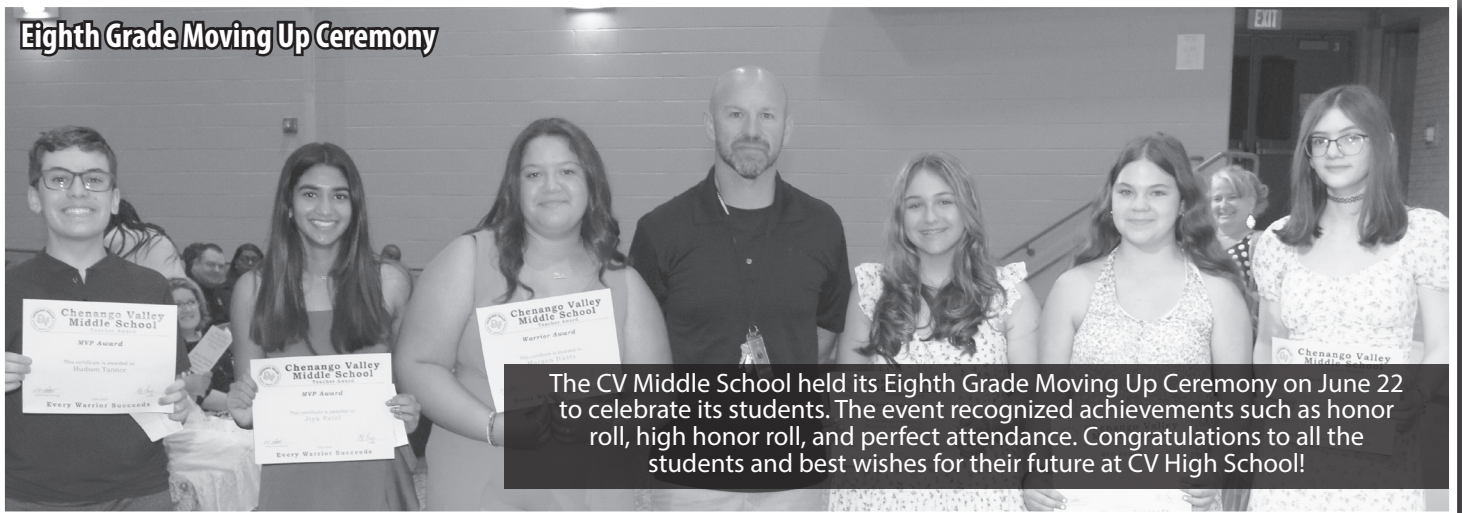
