Potential Capital Project Community Meeting - June 19th

Chenango Valley Central School District is currently evaluating a potential capital project that would be presented for public vote in December 2017. The potential project would address top priority capital improvements that will help to ensure the longevity of our facilities. The potential \$15 million capital project continues to support one of the goals of the Board of Education of controlling tax levy growth for our community. This project was designed to maintain a consistent tax effort for CV taxpayers.
