

Educational Excellence meeting 12/7/2020 started at 3:35 and finished at 4:30

Port Dickinson and Chenango Bridge data were reviewed: AIMS Web ELA and Math, Fountas and Pinnell Reading Level. Categories looked at were below grade level, approaching grade level, at grade level and above grade level. Absenteeism, discipline incidents, and free/reduced lunch data were also discussed.

CV Middle school data were reviewed in the following areas, passing vs failing, AIMS web ELA and Math, disciplinary, free and reduced lunch, and absenteeism.

CV High School data were reviewed in areas of passing vs failing, absenteeism, and free/reduced lunch.

Special Ed data were reviewed in the following areas, classified, declassified, in house, BOCES and private placements, transfers in and out and disability breakdown.

Pupil services update for all of the buildings. SST Secondary strategies include weekly meetings reviewing students with significant attendance or academic concerns. RTI all building teams worked over the summer to review process, procedures and Tier 1 strategies. Port Dickinson and Chenango Bridge, SEL and Safety lessons are delivered to all classrooms once during the 6-day cycle by the school counselor. Positivity project is continuing this year and begins in the classroom with the teacher and is followed up with the school counselor and social worker. Zones of Regulations is presented by the social workers for grades Kindergarten through 3. Backpack program has 50 students participating this year.

CV Middle school-school counselors push into Warrior Academy to provide SEL and college career lessons. Home visits are conducted by administrators, counselors and social workers. High School-many activities going on at the high school. Home visits done by administrators, counselors and social workers. Administrative intern is focusing on working with Grade 9 students who are struggling with attendance and passing courses.
