### **Update on the Seal of Civic Readiness-**

- 23 graduating seniors who potentially qualify for the Seal this year.
- Counselors are reviewing students' activities against the rubric and will then meet with students to discuss next steps.
- The BU Center for Civic Engagement has partnered with us to develop a student publication created by our middle school and high school students as a part of the Seal of Civic Readiness initiative.

### **Port Dickinson**

- PLC Development has continued at all grade levels, assessments to go with essential standards that have been identified is being developed
- Classroom teachers have identified data to inform small group instruction.
- Math Station work continues.
- PD Student Support Team meets regularly to discuss chronic attendance issues and create action plans.
- Field trips and assemblies are being planned for this school year.

### **Chenango Bridge**

- PLC Development: Team agendas are used for all CB meeting times; Essential Standards are established for Math/ElA for all Grade levels.
- Professional development: Grade level Math Data work to look through AIMS web data to develop successes and next steps for station work.
- Attendance committee meets every week.
- Mindful Mondays and Focused Fridays have continued during the school year.
- A family attendance flyer has been approved and will go home to PK-5 families.

### **Middle School**
