In the event of inclement weather, Commencement will be held in the Gymnasium. Tickets will be distributed after commencement rehearsal on June 24th. SENIORS WHO ARE WORKING: **In order to be eligible to participate in the Commencement Program, seniors must attend the entire rehearsal on Friday morning.** Therefore, anyone who is working should request permission to be absent from work. **The rehearsal begins at 9:00 A.M. and lasts approximately 1½ hours.** Employers are very cooperative in granting permission to attend.
