CALCULATING THE LIMIT

- **1.** Tax levy (11-12 school year)
- 2. Multiply by **tax base** growth factor (if any)
- 3. Add 11-12 **PILOTS**
- 4. Subtract taxes levied for 11-12 exemptions

Equals adjusted tax levy

- 5. Multiply by the allowable growth factor
- 6. Subtract 12-13 **PILOTS**
- 7. Add carryover (if any)

Equals "tax levy limit" for 12-13

8. Add 12-13 exemptions

Equals maximum allowable tax levy for 12-13

CONTINGENCY

- If the proposed budget is not approved by the required margin at the May vote...
- If the resubmitted/revised budget proposal is not approved by the required margin at the June vote...
- Contingent budgets
 - Remove all non-contingent expenses
 - Adhere to administrative cap
 - Old contingent versus new contingent
 - A budget that levies a tax no greater than that of the prior year (0% increase in tax levy)
