This course is designed to meet the state & national standards in art. This course is an introduction to basic skills and information needed to prepare the beginning art student for further study in art. The fundamentals of artistic design (Elements & Principles of Design) are taught along with the basic skills needed to create two-dimensional artwork. Students will use various mediums; pencil, marker, colored pencil, charcoal, paint, printmaking, and mixed media to create works of art. Students will be introduced to the uses and influences of two-dimensional art on various societies and cultures, historical and present.
