BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Chenango Valley Central School District, Broome County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The proposition hereinafter set forth is hereby authorized to be submitted for the approval of the qualified voters at the annual school district election to be held in said School District, on the 18th day of May, 2010.

<u>Section 2.</u> The School District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to include as a part of the notice of the annual district meeting and election notice with reference to the submission of said proposition in substantially the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that at said annual election to be held on May 18, 2010, the following proposition will be submitted:

CAPITAL RESERVE FUND PROPOSITION

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to-wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Chenango Valley Central School District, is hereby authorized to establish a capital reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law to be designated "School Facilities Reserve Fund" in order to pay costs of the construction, reconstruction and/or improvements of School Facilities, including original equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, furnishings, site improvements, land or rights-in-land, and other incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, and, in order to accomplish the same, said Board is hereby authorized to establish the ultimate amount of such Reserve Fund to be \$10,000,000 plus accrued interest and other investment earnings thereon with a probable term of ten years and, to appropriate annually from available fund balance and/or other legally available funds of the School District to such Reserve Fund.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the aforesaid proposition may appear on the ballot labels of the voting machines used at such Annual District Meeting in the following abbreviated form due to space constraints:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing of the qualified voters of the Chenango Valley Central School District, Broome County, New York, will be held in the Chenango Valley Middle School Library, 221 Chenango Bridge Road, Town of Fenton, Broome County, New York 13901, on **Tuesday, May 11, 2010**, at 7:00 p.m. (E.D.S.T.), for the presentation of the budget.

Date of Vote

Notice is also given that the annual meeting of qualified voters of the Chenango Valley Central School District for election of members of the Board of Education, votes upon appropriations of necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures (the Budget), and propositions involving the expenditure of money or authorizing the levy of taxes will take place on **Tuesday, May 18, 2010**, at the Chenango Valley Middle/High School in said district, Town of Fenton, Broome County, New York, 221 Chenango Bridge Road, between the hours of 12 noon and 9:00 p.m. (E.D.S.T.). Voting will be by voting machines.

Statement of Money Required for Next School Year

Notice is also given that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes exclusive of public moneys, may be obtained by any taxpayer in the District during the fourteen days immediately preceding the annual meeting, except Saturday, Sunday or holiday, at each office of the school houses in the District in which school is maintained from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Vote for Board Members

Notice is also given that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education must be filed in the office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. not later than the 30th day preceding May 18, 2010.

Two seats on the Chenango Valley Central School District Board of Education are to be filled by election. Both seats are for full five-year terms

Qualified Voters

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days preceding the annual vote and election. The School District may require all persons offering to vote at the budget vote and election to provide one form of proof of residency.

Qualified Voters (cont'd)

Such form may include a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the School District may also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.

Absentee Ballots

Applications for absentee ballots may be applied for at the District Office at 221 Chenango Bridge Road, Binghamton, NY 13901. Such applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the vote set in this notice if the ballot is to be mailed to the absentee voter or the day before the vote if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the absentee voter. Absentee ballots must be received in the office of the Clerk of the District not later than 5:00 p.m. on the date of the vote.

A list of all persons to whom absentee voters' ballots have been issued shall be available for public inspection during regular office hours that are between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. until the day of the election. Any qualified voter, may upon examination of such list, file written challenge of qualifications as a voter of any person whose name appears on such list, stating the reasons for the challenge. Such list shall be posted in a conspicuous place during the election, and any qualified voter may challenge the acceptance of the absentee voters' ballots or a person on such list, by making this challenge and the reasons for the challenge known to the inspectors of election before the close of the polls.

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase three (3) 65-passenger diesel school buses, one (1) 60-passenger wheelchair equipped school bus, and two (2) suburban style vehicles and to issue District obligations in the amount not to exceed \$450,000 including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto for the financing thereof.
